### **CALL for Maltese Participants: Malta Mobility Event**

**Dates:** 2<sup>nd</sup> March- 4<sup>th</sup> March 2013

**Application Deadline:** 19<sup>th</sup> February 2013

**Participating Countries:** Spain, Malta, Poland, Romania, Slovenia, Italy and the UK

**Costs of participation (including daily meals):** free of charge

**Activities:** The schedule of activities can be found on the last page.

- We will start off with a welcome reception on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of March.
- The highlight of the event will be the visit to Hagar Qim on March the 4<sup>th</sup> where Maltese adult learners will be given the possibility to tour guide the group around this world heritage site. This activity will be followed by a very interesting pottery workshop.
- A certification will be awarded at the end of the Malta Mobility Event.

#### **Description:**

Throughout the 2 years period the EPAEMSI project spans (August 2012-July 2014), adult learners from 7 different countries (organisations) have the opportunity to participate in a number of local activities run by every individual organisation as well as travel to a Mobility Event organised by the partner organisation. The aim of these events is to introduce participants to informal and non-formal learning and

through other different methods engage them in activities that would help reduce the risk of unemployment and social exclusion.

There are 7 international Mobility Events (about 2-3 days) organised in every partner country.

The second international Mobility Event will take place **in Malta** between **3<sup>rd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> March**. There is place for **5-8 Maltese participants** for this international Mobility Event. The advantage will be given to those who wish to attend one of the Mobility Events organised by international partner organisations abroad later on this year.

MUYA can send a total of **16 participants** (adult learners potentially at risk of social exclusion) and **8 accompanying** members (trainers, staff, organisation representatives) to 6 events taking place in the partner countries. The number of Maltese participants for each Mobility being held abroad ranges from 3 to 5. Every successful applicant going abroad to a Mobility event is expected to participate in the local workshops and pre-departure training organised by MUYA.

#### **The profile of participants for Malta Mobility Event:**

- To be over 18 years old (over 25 or between 18 and 25 who are no longer undergoing initial education within the formal school or higher education);
- From disadvantaged social groups which may include but is not limited to:
  - a) those with special needs;
  - b) groups facing socio-economic disadvantage;
  - c) those with few or no formal qualifications;
  - d) travellers, refugees, migrant workers;
  - e) those with disabilities;
  - f) minority ethnic groups;
  - g) individuals living in rural or deprived inner city areas;
  - h) those unemployed;
  - i) offenders and ex-offenders.

#### **Timeline of international Mobility Events:**

- 1) Spain - November 2012 (past)
- 2) Malta – 2<sup>nd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> March

- 3) Romania - May 2013
- 4) Poland - August 2013
- 5) Slovenia - November 2013
- 6) Italy - February/March 2013
- 7) UK - June 2014

Note: The exact dates of the international Mobility Events are not fixed yet as they are always agreed 2- 2.5 months in advance by all partner organisations.

**Local activities before Malta Mobility on 2nd-5th March 2013 for Maltese participants:**

**Last week of February** (date to be specified) - tutorial at Hagar Qim with Heritage Malta curators on "Tour guiding at Hagar Qim". Through this activity, local participants can learn about different aspects of Hagar Qim and practice tourguiding by giving a tour to our international group during the Mobility in Malta on the 4<sup>th</sup> March at 9:30.

Note: The exact date & time for the tutorial will be agreed with the potential participants and Heritage Malta a week in advance.
